Dr Julianne Jaques KC, CTA, is a barrister specialising in taxation law who has appeared in all higher Federal, Victorian and New South Wales Courts including the High Court in Bywater and Sharpcan. She is a member of the Federal Government’s Board of Taxation (reappointed 8 December 2023) and the Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority (reappointed 1 July 2022), and a former member of the Tax Practitioners Board (2016–2022).
